We notice a lot of our friends are mouthing toys and having a hard time sitting in their chairs. We are working on learning some new skills! Thank you for your help with this!

At drop off (and if you have to visit the building during the day but are not picking up), please park on the opposite side of the building from our classroom. Sometimes our friends get upset if they see their parent getting in the car.

This month we will focus on colors and shapes, apples, construction vehicles/building, fall, leaves, and Pete the Cat.
