Sunscreen: Please note that sunscreen is NOT a requirement! If we have sunscreen for a child we are required by law to apply it. Even when they're bundled up in the winter etc. Use your best judgment in choosing whether or not and when to bring in sunscreen. Many times during the hottest parts of the summer we can only be out for 15-30 minutes due to ozone codes. If your child needs sunscreen we do request the spray kind as they are easier to apply. We only apply sunscreen in the afternoon. Sunscreen forms are required and available upon request. Thank You!

The weather has been unpredictable! Please be sure your child has a variety of back up clothes in their bag. Please include long and short sleeved shirts and at least a light weight jacket.

VERY IMPORTANT INFO:



A note about potty training. We are so excited that everyone is in underwear. We have noticed that many of our friends are still having accidents well after transitioning to underwear. We have several friends who are dropping off with a pull-up on. We recommend that you only use pull-ups/ diapers for bedtime if needed. All of our friends go hours here without having accidents. We go outside in the morning and afternoon for an hour without coming in for potty. Our class knows we go potty before we go out and we do not come in. All of our friends also sleep a good two hour nap and do not have accidents. We find that if we do not catch that a child is in a pull-up at drop off then by 9, when we all potty before going out, many are soaking wet. Over the years we have found that if a child has a diaper or pull-up on they will use it and then often have accidents even when in underwear because they forget they are not wearing a pull-up. We are asking that you have your child potty before you leave the house (pull-up or not cause we've had some near misses with friends panicking because they have to go so bad). Please refrain from bringing your child in wearing a pull-up or diaper and using pull-ups or diapers when not at school.


