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A few important reminders:

Please be sure to let us know if your child will be absent from school so we may plan accordingly. Please do not set items on the mat shelves just inside our door as this is also our food service area and needs to stay clean and sanitized. There is a list of needed items in your welcome packet. We ask that when sending in a blanket for your child they are no bigger than 36' long and 24' wide. They need to fit on the mat with your child and not be all over the floor. We do not allow rain boots or pullups to be worn in our classroom. Rainboots make climbing outside dangerous. The same can be said for crocks. We ask they wear crocs as little as possible. Pull ups do not hold much, are difficult to change when a child is standing up (we don't have a changing table) and are expensive. When it comes to potty training please wait to bring your child to school in underwear until we have had a conversation. On that same note though if your child is potty training/ wearing underwear at home please discuss this with us so we can be on the same page. We ask that at drop off your child walks into the room as it helps with separation. Ms. Lynne has a bad back and is not supposed to lift but also cant help herself.

Small toys or lovies that help your child drop off happily are fine as long as they fit in your child's bookbag and it can still be zippered. Our rule is that they go in their book bags before morning snack. Morning snack is 8:30- 8:45 and is just a snack. We need to be finishing at 8:45 so everyone is changed and ready to go outside at 9. Please bring in your labeled family pictures as soon as possible.
